WHAT TO REPORT

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Report in Items 1 through 12, the quantities of sugar delivered during the month to users for direct consumption--including quantities delivered **for the account of** other primary distributors (*sugar beet/sugarcane processors and cane refiners*) but excluding quantities delivered to users **for your account** by other primary distributors.

Direct consumption sugar does not include sugar distributed to other primary distributors. Sugar is delivered when the title to the sugar changes.

Commercial weight: in hundredweight on adjusted commercial weight for the same sugar as reported in raw value on Forms CCC-831, CCC-832, or CCC-835. Non-crystalline sugars (*includes liquid, edible molasses, sugar syrups, and cane syrups*) should be reported on the basis of sugar-solids content.

GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS

In breaking down or grouping deliveries by areas, use the following classification of States to determine areas:

New England - includes Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - includes New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.
